Are the Bose Surround Speakers wireless?

Yes. The Bose Surround Speakers connect wirelessly to the Bose Soundbar 500 and the Bose Soundbar 700—so no wires are required from the front of the room to the rear. However, the Bose Surround Speakers do require electrical power to power the wireless receiver and there is a speaker wire connecting the wireless receiver to the speaker itself.

Can the Bose Surround Speakers be wired to the Bose Soundbar 500 and Bose Soundbar 700?

No. The Bose Surround Speakers can only be connected wirelessly.

What is the range of the wireless link between the Bose Soundbar 500 and Bose Soundbar 700 and the Bose Surround Speakers?

The Bose Surround Speakers are intended for use in the same room as the Bose Soundbar 500 and Bose Soundbar 700 and they have a range of about 9 m.

What placement guidelines should be considered to ensure optimal audio performance of the Bose Surround Speakers?

We recommend placing the speakers behind the main listening area—one on the left side and one on the right side of the room—for optimum sound quality.
