

Thank you for choosing the Melissa & Doug Multi-Activity Play Table! It's a terrific way to help nurture a child's creativity and imagination, and to inspire hands-on independent play for years to come.

NOW IT'S TIME TO PUT IT TOGETHER!

Don't worry, assembling your new table is simple, and we're here to help. It may go a little faster with a partner to lend a hand, but we've made it so one person can assemble the table. Here are a few tips before you begin:

- Read through all the instructions first.
- Clear a flat, covered space (carpeted is best) to lay out all the materials so everything is close at hand.
- You will need a Phillips head screwdriver (not included) to assemble the table. We've included everything else you need. All parts are labeled with a sticker (A-X).
- The instructions include lots of helpful pictures—we show you, step-by-step, how to align pieces and parts for speedy and accurate assembly. Note that the hardware needed for each step is shown in the upper right corner of the page, each piece being added in a given step is highlighted in gray, and the "assembled view" (what it looks like in the completed product when the step is completed) is included in the lower right corner of every page.
- In the instructions, the name of a part is followed by a letter in parentheses. This letter corresponds to the sticker on the part, as well as the picture of the part shown on pages 2-3.
- Helpful hints are highlighted with a large exclamation point.

Warning—Prevent Tip Overs!


- Do not allow children to pull, climb, sit, or stand on any part of the table.

MAINTENANCE:


Ensure the table continues to function properly and safely by regularly checking the hardware and tightening when necessary.

PARTS - Be Smart—Sort Your Parts


Before you begin assembly, make sure you have all the parts listed below. Use the Allen wrench (part X) to attach the bolts and a Phillips head screwdriver (not included) to attach the screws and align the barrel nuts.






B side drawer panels (2)




C bottom drawer panel







- Note: Some packages of hardware may have extra pieces.

How to Correctly Install Barrel Nuts





STEP 1 - Every Journey Begins with the First Step



- First, attach the 2 side drawer panels (part B) to the rear drawer panel (part A) using 4 long bolts (part R) and 4 barrel nuts (part S). Make sure the grooves on the bottom of all the panels face the inside.



- Second, slide the bottom drawer panel (part C) into the grooves on the drawer assembly.
- Third, using 4 long bolts (part R) and 4 barrel nuts (part S), attach the front drawer panel (part D) to the drawer assembly.





IMPORTANT:
Make sure the grooves on the inside are aligned.



STEP 2 - Side by Side



Using 4 short bolts (part T) and 4 bolt caps (part U), attach the side supports (part E) to the side panels (part F).

STEP 3 - We're Here to Support You



- First, using 2 short bolts (part T) and 2 bolt caps (part U), attach a front/rear support (part G) to the rear panel (Part I).
- Second, using 2 short bolts (part T) and 2 bolt caps (part U), attach remaining front/rear support (part G) to the front panel (part H).

STEP 4 - Be Wise—Stabilize




Using 2 short screws (part V),
attach the drawer stabilizer (part J)
to the front panel (part H).




STEP 5 - That's Right

Using 2 long bolts (part R) and 2 barrel nuts (part S), attach the right side panel (part F) to the rear panel (part I).



STEP 6 - Put Up a Good Front




Using 2 long bolts (part R) and 2 barrel nuts (part S), attach the front panel (part H) to the table assembly.

STEP 7 - What's Left

Using 4 long bolts (part R) and 4 barrel nuts (part S), attach the left side panel (part F) to the table assembly.





STEP 8 - Let's Get to the Bottom of It

Using 4 long screws (part W),
attach the bottom side supports
(part K) to the left and right
sides of the table.



IMPORTANT: Because the screw holes are close to the ground, you may find it easier to tilt the table onto its side to install these screws.





STEP 9 - Don't Be Cross

Using 4 long screws (part W), attach the table cross supports (part L) to the front and rear supports on the inside of the table.




IMPORTANT: Make sure the notches in the cross supports are facing up.

STEP 10 - There's More—a Drawer


Slide the drawer into the opening in the front of the table.

STEP 11 - This Dowel Will Do Well

Slide the wooden dowel (part M) through the hole in the back of the drawer and into the notch in the front support.



STEP 12 - Extra Support

Using 2 long screws (part W), attach the drawer support (part N) to the table cross supports. Make sure the notch in the drawer support is facing the drawer. Slide the wooden dowel (part M) into the notch in the drawer support.



! **IMPORTANT:** You may need to rotate the front of the drawer slightly downward for the dowel to fit.

STEP 13 - Brace Yourself


Using 8 long screws (part W),
attach the 4 corner braces
(part O) to the notches in both
the table cross supports and
the front/rear supports.

STEP 14 - Top it Off

- First, slide the 4 rubber bumpers (part P) onto the a long side of the surface panels (part Q). Each panel will have two bumpers.
- Second, place the surface panels (part Q) onto the table.

It's the perfect spot for drawing, painting, or other arts and crafts projects. Spread out picture books, arrange dolls or stuffed animals, or clear a spot for a tea party!
- **LARGE PLAY AREA:** With approximately 11 square feet (3.35 square meters) of play space, there's ample room for independent play or for lots of kids to play together. There's even enough space for multiple activities at once!
- **JUST THE RIGHT HEIGHT:** At 17.5 inches tall, the activity table works for small and tall alike—toddlers will use it as they learn to stand and walk, and older kids will gather around it on knees, pillows, or kid-sized chairs for years to come!
- **STORAGE DRAWER:** Use the jumbo-sized pull out drawer for convenient storage of train tracks, puzzle and game pieces, craft supplies, and more. It's perfect for keeping toys and crafts together, in reach, and off the floor!
- **LIFT-OUT PLAY BOARDS:** Clean up is a breeze thanks to play boards that can easily be lifted out and wiped down!
